The Youngville Cafe Farmers Market is sponsored by the Youngville Highway History Association, Inc. The market is intended to provide area producers the opportunity to sell approved items which they have baked, grown or handcrafted.

Market hours are from 3:30 to 6:00 p.m. each Friday beginning May 25th and extending through October 19th. The cost of the market is \$50.00 per season (23 sale days) or \$5.00 per market day. Persons purchasing a season pass will have the benefit of a reserved booth space. Vendors who pay per market day will have access to booth space on a first come-first serve basis. The Youngville Highway History Association, Inc. will advertise the market with roadside signs, flyers and by placing ads in the local papers and Cedar Rapids Gazette. A market master will be at the site for the purpose of facilitating the market on sale days.

In order for the market to run smoothly for everyone, we ask that you observe the following rules:

- Season passes should be purchased at the start of the season.
- Per market day participants must sign in and pay the daily fee before the start of sales.
- No sales before the 3:30 pm start time.
- Vendors will be responsible for providing their own tables, chairs, etc.
- Vendors will be responsible for cleanup of their booth site before leaving the grounds.
- The offering for sale of any item acquired from others (resale or consignment) is not permitted.
- Vendors are not to set up earlier than 2:45 p.m.
- Fresh fruits and vegetables must be washed and stored in clean containers off the ground.
- Baked goods and honey must be completely wrapped and labeled with name of product and name & address of person selling them. Store off the ground in clean containers.
- Eggs must be stored in refrigerated container at 60 degrees or below. Cannot be stored or sold in USDA-certified containers. Customers can bring their own egg cartons.

Items not approved for sale:

- Meat, fish poultry or products containing these
- Dairy products
- Soft pies and baked goods with custard or cream fillings.
- Home canned fruits and vegetables
- Home processed foods (egg noodles, salsas, etc.)
- Unless a state license is procured by the individual vendor, food stalls vending individual portions for consumption on the premises are not allowed.
